Open iPhone Settings

Privacy and Security

- Location Services
 - Select Location Alerts, confirm "show map..." is turned off
 - Confirm no apps listed are set to "always"
 - Scroll to the bottom of the listed apps, and select System Services
 - Select Significant Locations > turn OFF and clear history
 - Back out to System Services > turn OFF iPhone Analytics, Routing & Traffic, and Improve Maps
- Tracking
 - Turn OFF "Allow Apps to Request to Track"
- Contacts
 - Confirm apps with access to your phone book/contacts
- Photos
 - Confirm apps with access to your photos
- Microphone
 - Confirm apps with access to your microphone
- Camera
 - Confirm apps with access to your camera
- Analytics & Improvements
 - Turn OFF
- Apple Advertising
 - Turn OFF personalized ads

Face ID & Passcode

- Face ID with a Mask
 - Turn OFF
- Require Attention for Face ID
 - Turn ON
- Require Passcode
 - Immediately
- Turn OFF all options to Allow Access When Locked

Apple ID, iCloud, Media & Purchases

- Click on your name at the top of the main Settings screen
- Sign-In & Security
 - Two-Factor Authentication > Turn ON
 - Verify your trusted phone number
- iCloud
 - iCloud Backup > Turn ON
 - Private Relay > Turn ON
 - Advanced Data Protection
 - Turn ON > choose recovery contact option

NOTE: This may require updating any devices connected to iCloud account before Advanced Data Protection can be enabled.

- Access iCloud Data on the Web > Turn ON
- Verify list of devices connected to your Apple ID
 - Select any device(s) that may be old or unknown
 - "Remove from Account"
